- b. This battle has been fought for many years
- c. This topic discusses this battle and what it means to us

### I. How Did It Begin?

- a. It began with Lucifer (Satan) – I John 3:8, Rev. 12:9
- b. Lucifer was a created being – an angel – Ezekiel 28:13,15
- c. He became jealous of God (Jesus) – Isaiah 14:13,14, Eze. 28:17
- d. He wanted to be worshipped like God

### II. What Are the Issues?

- a. All about WORSHIP – Eze. 28:14-15
- b. Satan tempted Jesus in wilderness to worship him – Matt. 4:8-11
- c. Everybody worships something
- d. God says, :”Thou shalt not have any other gods before Me”

### III. What Happened as a Result ?

- a. Satan rebelled against God
- b. Satan convinced 1/3 of angels to join his rebellion
- c. War broke out in heaven between Jesus (Michael) and Satan Rev. 12:7-9
- d. Satan loses and is cast out of heaven with his angels – heaven rejoices
- e. Satan and angels end up on earth - woe unto inhabitants on earth

### IV. How Did We Get Involved ?

- a. Satan disguised as a serpent tempts Eve to eat forbidden fruit- Gen 2:17
- b. Eve convinces Adam to eat fruit – Gen. 3:1-8
- c. Both Adam and Eve are reprimanded by God. – Gen 3:9-24
- d. God sentences them to death, but offers hope – Gen 3:15

### V. How Has Sin Affected Us ?

- a. Death is passed on to human race because of Adam’s sin – Gen. 3:19
- b. Satan has dominion on earth to cause destruction – Job 2:2
- c. Satan has God’s permission to demonstrate his plan – Rev. 12:12
- d. This explains why “Bad things happen to good people” – 1 Peter 5:8

- b. Secular history confirms Bible prophecy
- c. We are living in the feet and toes of human history
- d. Christ (the stone) is about to set up His kingdom
- e. The book of Daniel was “shut up” until the time of the end – Dan. 12:4

#### **II. How Does the Bible Describe the End-Time?**

- a. Many shall run to and fro - Dan. 12:4
- b. Knowledge shall increase – Dan. 12:4
- c. Perilous times shall come – 2 Tim 3:1-5

#### **III. What Are the Top 10 Signs of the End-Time?**

- a. False Christ – Matt. 24:45
- b. Wars and Rumors of Wars – v34:6,7
- c. Famines – v24:7
- d. Pestilences – v34:7
- e. Earthquakes – 24:7
- f. Persecution – v24:9
- g. Abounding Wickedness – v24:12
- h. Sun, Moon, and Stars – Luke 21:25

- i. Worldwide Fear – v21:25,26
- j. Worldwide proclamation of the Gospel – Matt.24:12,14

- b. God’s mercy and longsuffering has its limit-2 Peter 3:9
- c. God’s Spirit will not always strive with man-Gen. 6-3
- d. This topic reveals God’s Last warning to man

#### **I. Where Is It Revealed?**

- a. The Book of Revelation
- b. Revelation is Jesus’ book – Rev. 1:1-3
- c. Written for people of the end time – Rev 1:19
- d. The name “Revelation” means “Revealing”

#### **II. How Will It Be Given?**

- a. Symbolized by three angels of Revelation 14
- b. The word “Angel” means “Messenger”
- c. God messages will be given with super-natural power

#### **III. What Is It About?**

- a. It is the Everlasting Gospel – Salvation in Jesus alone-  
John 14:6
  - i. NOT Salvation by works – Eph. 2:8
  - ii. NOT Salvation in Sin – Matt. 1:21
- b. It will be preached to every person on earth – Rev.  
14:6
- c. It will be a powerful witness unto all the world – Matt.  
24:14

- d. It will be a three-point message:
  - i. God’s Judgment hour has arrived – Rev. 14:6
  - ii. Come out of fallen Babylon – Rev. 14:8,18:4
  - iii. Beware of the Mark of the Beast – Rev. 14:9,10

#### **IV. How Should We Respond?**

- a. God’s message calls for a decision
- b. Elijah’s message challenged people to make a decision
- c. God’s people will respond by:
  - i. Keeping His commandments – John 14:15
  - ii. Maintaining faith in Jesus – Rev. 14:12

### **CLOSING THOUGHTS:**

- a. God’s final message is one of love
- b. Jesus does not want anyone to perish – 2 Peter 3:9
- c. Heed God’s final warning – Revelation 18:4
- d. “Choose ye this day whom ye will serve” – Josh. 24:15

# No. 7 – Judgment Day

## **INTRODUCTION:**

- a. A day is coming in which God will review lives of everyone on earth
- b. Bible mentions a judgment more than 1000 times
- c. Its importance cannot be over-emphasized
- d. Main purpose of the Judgment is to vindicate God's character
- e. There are three phases of the judgment

### **I. First Phase – Investigative Judgment**

- a. Takes place before Jesus' second coming
- b. Determines who will be saved or lost
- c. Judgment begins at the house of God (Church) – I Pet. 4:17
- d. Ends before Jesus' second coming – Rev22:11,2
- e. God the Father, the ancient of days presides – Dan 7:9,10
- f. Jesus is defense attorney – 1 John 2:1
- g. The Father has committed all judgment to the Son – John 5:22
- h. Satan is the only accuser – Rev. 12:9,10
- i. The evidence will be the Books – Dan 7:10, Rev. 20:12
- j. God will bring every work into judgment – Eccl 12:14

### **II. Second Phase – Millennial Judgment**

- a. Takes place after Jesus' return
- b. Saints shall judge the world & angels – I Cor 6:2,3
- c. Judgment will be given to the saints – Rev. 20:4
- d. This will answer all questions of the righteous about the wicked

### **III. Third Phase – Executive Judgment**

- a. Takes place after the millennium
- b. Wicked from all ages along with Satan and angels will be present
- c. Satan convinces them to take New Jerusalem – Rev. 20:9
- d. All the wicked face God as He Executes Judgment
- e. Every knee shall bow and confess that Jesus is Lord!
- f. Fire comes down from God and destroys Satan, his angels, and all the wicked.

## **CLOSING THOUGHTS:**

- a. God's character will be fully vindicated in the judgment
- b. Judgment will be decided in favor of God's people
- c. The righteous will be safe from sin for eternity
- d. Sin will be completely eradicated and will never rise a second time

## No. 6 – Babylon is Fallen

### INTRODUCTION:

- a. Bible speaks about the Bride of Christ in Revelation
- b. But there is another women trying to seduce believers from Christ
- c. Revelation describes her as “**Babylon**”
- d. Christ’s people must escape her charm or perish
- e. This topic will reveal the real truth about Babylon

### I. What Does Babylon Mean?

- a. The name originated at the Tower of Babel – Gen. 11:1-9
- b. Babylon means “Confusion” – Tower of Babel
- c. Revelation describes her as “Mystery Babylon, The Great Mother of Harlots” – Rev.17:1-5
- d. The woman of Revelation 17 represents the apostate church
- e. The beast of Revelation 17 represents the civil government
- f. The woman riding the beast means that the church is in control of the government
- g. This woman (church) persecuted the saints
- h. She was dressed in purple and scarlet
- i. The beast had seven heads and is guilty of blasphemy
- j. The woman (church) ruled over the kings of the earth
- k. “Mystery Babylon, The Great Mother of Harlots” symbolizes the *Roman Catholic Church*
- l. Apostate churches are her offspring – also harlots
- m. Babylon is a term which describes all religious bodies and movements that have fallen away from the truth (Apostatized)

### II. Why Is It Fallen?

- a. Because “She made all nations drink of the wine of her fornication” – Rev. 14:8

- b. Spiritual fornication means to **turn away** from the truth and true worship of God
- c. “All the nations of the earth” refers to all churches and religious bodies who accept her false teachings
- d. Churches that adopt the teachings of Mother Babylon, become “Babylon” themselves
- e. Satan’s strategy is to deceive all who will not demand scriptural proof – 2 Tim. 3:4
- f. God’s strategy to counter deception is Isaiah 8:20

### III. What is Babylon’s Wine?

- a. False doctrines – Rev. 17:4
- b. Worship of Images – Ex. 20:4
- c. Immortality of the Soul – Gen. 3:4
- d. Eternally burning Hell – Mal. 4:1,3
- e. Infant Baptism – Matt. 28:19,20
- f. Sunday Sacredness – Ex. 20:8
- g. Confessions to Priests – I Tim. 2:5
- h. Traditions above the Bible – Mark 7:7

### IV. What Must We Do About Babylon?

- a. Come out of Babylon – Rev. 18:4,5
- b. Do not stay and try to reform it!
- c. Babylon is going to be destroyed, not reformed
- d. She will become hopelessly drunk with her wine
- e. That’s why God calls His people to “COME OUT!”

### CLOSING THOUGHTS:

- a. God is calling His “Sheep” from other folds (Churches) – John 10:16
- b. God’s sheep will hear his voice – John 10:16
- c. Jesus is knocking at the door of your heart – Rev. 3:20

# No. 5 – The Mark of the Beast

## INTRODUCTION:

- a. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Angel of Revelation also has a very solemn message for those living during the End-Time.
- b. Like the two Angels before, his message involves True and False WORSHIP
- c. This topic discusses an identifying mark that will be placed upon False Worshipers-The Mark of the Beast!

### I. Who Is The Beast

- a. God reveals the identity of the Beast in Rev. 13
- b. 10 Characteristics of the Beast
  - Rises from the sea (*populated area*) – Rev. 13:1
  - Composite of four beasts (*four kingdoms*) – Dan. 7:2
  - Dragon gives it power (*Satan gives it power*) – Rev.13:2
  - Receives a deadly wound (*Pope Pius dies in exile*) – v.3
  - Deadly wound healed (*Pope restored to power*) – v.3
  - Strong political power (*Papacy*) – v.3
  - Strong religious power (*Papacy*) – v.3
  - Guilty of blasphemy (*Pope claims to be God*) – v.6
  - Makes wars with Saints (*a persecuting church*) – v.7
  - Mysterious number 666 (*Vicarius Filii Dei*) – v.18
- c. Only one power has all these characteristics – **The Papacy!**

### II. What Is His Mark

- a. The Catholic Church's Mark of Authority to change the day of worship from Sabbath to Sunday
- b. The Bible predicted the Beast would try to change God's laws – Dan 7:25
- c. The Catholic Church:
  - a. Omitted the 2<sup>nd</sup> Commandment – Ex.20:4,5
  - b. Shortened the 4<sup>th</sup> Commandment – Ex. 20:8
  - c. Divided the 10<sup>th</sup> Commandment into two

- d. The Mark of the Beast encompasses much more than changing from Sunday to Saturday. It involves a decision regarding True and False Worship!

### III. How Do You Receive It?

- a. In your forehead or in your hand – Rev. 14:9,10
  - Forehead – refers to our mind, the seat of intellectual decisions.
  - Hand – refers to our actions, our behaviors, the things we do to support it
- b. Four important points to remember:
  - No one has received the Mark of the Beast yet.
  - It will be given when Sunday-keeping is enforced by law
  - To keep the Mark of the Beast is to fail to keep God's sacred Sabbath
  - A relationship with Christ is more important than obedience to the Beast!

### IV. What Will Happen To Those Who Receive It?

- a. You won't be able to buy or sell anything unless you receive the Mark of the BEAST – Rev. 13:16,17
- b. Those receiving the Mark of the Beast will suffer the full wrath of God (seven last plagues) and be tormented with fire and brimstone – Rev. 14:9-11

### V. How Can We Avoid It?

- a. Cultivate a genuine relationship with Jesus through; Bible Study, Prayer, and Witnessing.
- b. Its all about True or False WORSHIP!

## CLOSING THOUGHTS:

- a. God is calling His people to Worship Him in Truth!
- b. Those who obey will receive the Seal of God (Sabbath)
- c. Those who refuse to obey will receive the Mark of the Beast (Sunday)

## No. 4 – The Close of Probation

### INTRODUCTION:

- a. Before Jesus returns, every human being on planet earth will have an opportunity to make their final decision regarding truth
- b. This decision period is referred to as “The Close of Probation”
- c. This topic discusses the following questions regarding the Close of Probation:

#### I. What Does It Mean?

- a. The time when people all over the world make their final decisions about the truth, thereby sealing their eternal destiny (A Process over Time)
- b. The time when Jesus ceases His mediatorial ministry in the heavenly sanctuary (A Point in Time)

#### II. How Will It Affect the World?

- a. Before Probation Closes there are three classes of people in the world:
  1. Those who are loyal to Jesus
  2. Those who are loyal to Satan
  3. Those who are undecided
- b. After Probation Closes only two classes of people will remain:
  1. Those who are loyal to Jesus (receiving the Seal of God)
  2. Those who are loyal to Satan (receiving the Mark of the Beast)
- c. Biblical examples of Two classes of people:
  1. OT – Noah’s Ark – Gen:6, Sodom and Gomorrah – Gen 18:22-23, The Jewish People – Dan 9:24
  2. NT – The Ten Virgins – Matt. 25:1-3, The Wheat and Tares – Matt. 13:24-30, The Sheep and Goats – Matt. 25:31-36

#### III. When Will It Close?

- a. For the Individual

1. When a person dies – No more opportunity to change their decision
  2. When a person commits the Unpardonable Sin – by rejecting truth!
- b. For the World:
    1. When Jesus ceases His Mediatorial ministry in heaven as our High Priest!
    2. “He that is unjust, let him be unjust still...” – Rev. 22:11

#### IV. What Will Happen After It Closes?

- a. There shall be a Time of Trouble such as never was since there was a nation – Dan. 12:1
- b. The Seven Last Plagues will fall on those who have rejected the truth and received the Mark of the Beast!
- c. The Second Coming of Christ! – Behold He cometh with clouds... – Rev. 1:7

#### V. How Can We Prepare For It?

- a. Preparation involves mainly three steps:
  1. Conviction – Ask God to Show you your sins – Ps. 139:23,24
  2. Conversion – Ask God to Change your desire to sin – Ps. 51:10
  3. Resistance – Ask God to give you power to resist sin – Phil. 4:13
- b. Two Important Principles to Remember:
  1. Only God can change our *Desires*
  2. Only We can change our *Behaviors* (with God’s help)

### CLOSING THOUGHTS:

- a. The Close of Probation is the most important event that will take place on earth before Jesus returns
- b. If you are not prepared when your probation closes, then you will not be prepared for Jesus’ return
- c. Make your final decision regarding truth TODAY!

### INTRODUCTION:

- a. In the last days there will be scoffers saying, “Where is the promise of His coming? - 2 Pet. 3:4
- b. Many believe that “God is Dead”

### I. Is Jesus Really Coming?

- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Coming Assured!
  - OT Prophets foretold His first coming – Isaiah 6:14
  - Angels announced His arrival – Luke 2:11
  - NT Apostles affirmed that He came – John 1:14
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming Assured!
  - The Apostles preached He’d come again – I Thess. 4:16
  - Angels assured He’d come again – Acts 1:11
  - Jesus Himself declared He’d come again – John 14:1-3

### II. Why Hasn’t He Come Yet?

- a. Gospel work not finished – Matt.24:12
- b. We are not ready to receive Him – Matt. 24:37-39
- c. God is patient and longsuffering – 2 Pet. 3:9
- d. God’s People not yet sealed – Rev. 7:1-3

### III. When Will He Come?

- a. The specific day or hour has not been revealed – Mark 13:32
- b. God’s time is not the same as ours – 2 Pet. 3:8
- c. Our time is limited by death – Heb. 9:27
- d. When the Gospel work is finished – Matt. 24:12
- e. When all the signs have been fulfilled – Luke 21:28
  - Perilous Times – 2 Tim 3:1-5
  - Earthquakes – Luke 21:11
  - False Christ’s – Matt.24:
  - Persecution – Matt. 24:21
  - Wars and Rumors – Matt. 24:
  - Abounding Wickedness
  - Famines – Matt. 24:
  - Sun, moon and stars

- Pestilences – Matt. 24
  - World-wide fear – Luke 21
- f. When you least expect Him – Matt. 24:44

### IV. How Will He Come?

- a. Same manner in which He left – Acts 1:11
- b. Behold He cometh with clouds – Rev. 1:7, Matt. 24:27
- c. With a shout and the sound of trumpets – I Thess. 4:16,17
- d. With myriads of Holy Angels – Matt. 25:31
- e. They shall see the Son of Man coming – Matt. 24:30
- f. The Secret Rapture is NOT biblical!!!

### V. How to Prepare to Meet Him?

- a. Building Faith in Jesus – John 14:6
- b. Spending time in prayer – I Thess. 5:17
- c. Studying God’s Word – 2 Tim. 2:15
- d. Seeking God’s Will – Prov. 3:6
- e. Gaining Victory over Sin – James 4:7
- f. Loving One Another – John 15:12
- g. Attending Church Regularly – Heb. 10:25
- h. Living with Expectancy – Matt. 24:42,44

- b. Seven Last Plagues – Rev. 16:1
- c. Second Coming of Jesus – Rev. 1:7
- d. Righteous Dead Resurrected – Rev. 20:4-6
- e. All Righteous given Immortality – I Cor. 15:51,52
- f. Righteous caught up in the clouds – I Thess. 4:17
- g. All Living Wicked Slain – 2 Thess. 2:8, Jer. 25:33
- h. Wicked dead remain in their graves – Rev. 20:5
- i. Jesus takes Righteous to Heaven – Matt 24:34
- j. Satan is Bound in Bottomless Pit – Rev. 20:1-3

#### **II. Events During the Millennium**

- a. Earth in battered condition from earthquakes & plagues
- b. Earth in Total Blackout – Jer. 4:23
- c. Satan and his angels are forced to stay on the earth – Rev. 20:1-3
- d. All the Saints are in Heaven Judging the Wicked – Rev. 20:4, I Cor. 6:2,3
- e. All Wicked are Dead on the Earth – Jer. 25:33

#### **III. Events After the Millennium**

- a. The third Coming of Jesus
- b. The Holy City descends to the earth – Rev. 21:2,3
- c. God the Father comes with Jesus – Zech. 14:5
- d. Wicked Dead are Raised – John 5:29, Rev. 20:5
- e. Satan is Loosed – Rev. 20:5,7,8
- f. Satan Deceives the entire World to Battle against God – Rev. 20:8
- g. Wicked surround the Holy City – Rev. 20:7-9
- h. Satan and Wicked Destroyed by Fire (Hell) – Rev. 20:9,10

#### **IV. What Will Happen Next?**

- a. God Creates a New Heaven and Earth – Isaiah 65:17
- b. God's People enjoy eternity in the New Earth – Rev. 21:3

### **CLOSING THOUGHTS:**

- a. The Great Controversy is Ended. Sin and Sinners are no more
- b. One Pulse of Harmony beats throughout the vast creation
- c. All things, animate and inanimate declare, "God is Love"

- a. It will be a Real Place – John 14:1-3
- b. It will have Real People – Phil. 3:21
- c. They will have Real Bodies – Luke 24:36-43
- d. They will be doing Real Things – Isaiah 65:21
- e. The Capital City will be a perfect square – Rev. 21:16
- f. It will be a walled city with 12 gates – Rev. 21:12
- g. Walls made of jasper – Rev. 21:11
- h. Each gate made of a solid pearl – Rev. 21:21
- i. Streets made of pure gold – Rev. 21:18
- j. The Tree of Life will be in the midst of the city – Rev. 22:2

### **II. Who Will Live There?**

- a. Jesus says, “The meek shall inherit the earth” – Matt.5:5
- b. God’s People will dwell in a peaceable habitation – Isaiah 32:18
- c. Jesus Himself will dwell there with His people – Rev. 21:3
- d. Boys and girls will be playing in the streets – Zech. 8:5
- e. Animals of all kind will dwell there – Isaiah 11:6,9

### **III. Who Will Not Live There?**

- a. The Unrighteous – “Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God?” I Cor. 6:9

- b. “Be not deceived: neither fornicators, Idolaters, adulterers, nor effeminate, nor thieves, nor drunkards ...shall inherit the kingdom of God.” I Cor. 6:9,10
- c. “Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murderers, drunkenness, revelries, and the like...those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.” Galatians 5:19-21

- d. No more Sea – Rev. 21:1

- g. No more Violence – Isaiah 60:18
- h. No more Death – Rev. 21:4
